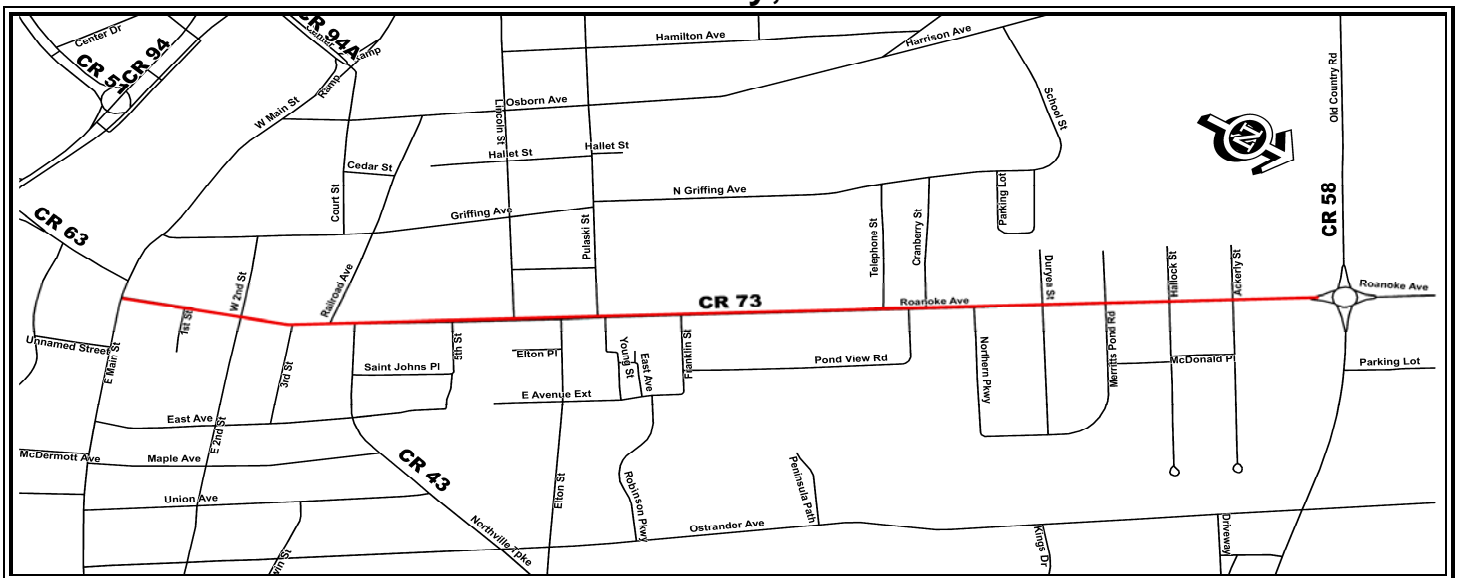

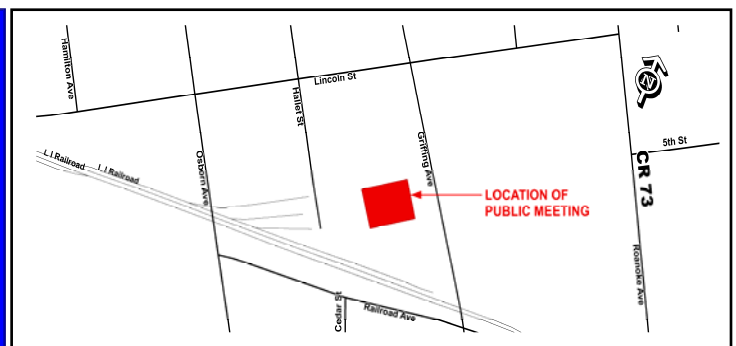

PURPOSE OF THE PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

The Suffolk County Department of Public Works will hold a public information meeting on Thursday, March 27, 2014 for the proposed improvements to County Road 73, Roanoke Avenue, from State Route 25, Main Street to County Road 58, Old Country Road.

The purpose of this meeting is to provide interested parties with an opportunity to examine the proposed design concept and offer comments to be considered by the County in developing the design of the project.

The public meeting will include exhibits presenting the proposed improvements. Suffolk County Department of Public Works representatives familiar with the design will be available to answer questions related to the project proposals.

Oral comments may be presented to County representatives on an individual basis between 6:00 P.M. and 8:00 P.M. Written comments may be submitted at the meeting or submitted by mail on forms that will be provided.

The Suffolk County Department of Public Works thanks you for your participation and input in the roadway design process. All information and comments received as part of this Public Information Meeting will be considered in developing a design that is most beneficial to local residents, businesses, and the traveling public.

PROJECT SUMMARY

The project is approximately 1.3 miles long. The primary objectives of the project are to rehabilitate existing pavement, drainage systems, curbs and sidewalks on Roanoke Avenue.

The key features of the project are as follows:

- Reduce travel lanes to consistent 11 foot width. Make shoulders a consistent 4 foot width.
- Rehabilitate existing asphalt pavement using a combination of full depth restoration and resurfacing (mill/overlay)
- Make all sidewalks ADA compliant – 5' minimum width, meet slope requirements, ramps and detectable warnings at intersections
- Replace curbs that have insufficient reveals (less than 4") and/or are deteriorated
- Remove trees that are causing heaving and/or safety issues and plant new street/wire friendly trees
- Rehabilitate/replace existing drainage system and add leaching basins to reduce flow to outfall.
- Install Hydrodynamic Stormwater Treatment Systems at discharge locations to treat remaining stormwater flow
